We had good attendance through the holidays and saw some unexpected faithfulness by folks we've prayed about for a long time. Small victories are often of great value in God's economy.

Please keep praying for men to answer the call to the far north. The need is as great as ever. Certainly pioneer missionaries are needed to bring Light to dark places in the circumpolar arctic, but the need for men to replace missionaries who have left ministries for various reasons seems to be increasing. Ministries ready to open the doors on day one. Ministries with believers praying for a preacher. I know the idea of planting a ministry as a pioneer missionary is the passion of some, and glory to God for that. But remember, before I started the church plant here in the Yukon, I was what I called an Apollos. Not the planter, but the waterer. "I [Paul] have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase." (1 Corinthians 3:6) One is not lesser, Planter or waterer. In a sense, Gary planted, Steve watered and God gave the increase. As well, Paul writes in the epistles as to the value of those assisting him. Missionaries always need help. Please read that again. Missionaries always need help.
